School Inspection/Audit Reports:

Each school or site is inspected on an annual basis. A copy of your completed report must be posted on the Health and Safety Bulletin Board. The report identifies safety concerns with recommendations and timelines. If these concerns are not being addressed, notify your principal and contact the Health and Safety Officer (905-751-8334) so that it can be followed up.

Here is a partial list of classroom-based items:

- Report missing eyewash bottles in Science room
- Science teacher with plumbed-in eyewash stations to flush on a weekly basis
- Report missing Fire Exit posters or Lockdown posters
- Ensure that all exits and fire exits are clear and free of obstructions
- Remove hallway obstructions (e.g. TV/VCRs, boxes or furniture)
- Report and remove all defective electrical cords (ground pins missing)
- Ensure that all cleaning solutions are Board approved and locked in storage (no home-bought cleaners are allowed)
- Report all trip hazards (torn carpet, broken tiles, etc.)
- Use proper grid hooks (butterfly hooks) to suspend materials from the ceiling no lower than two meters from the floor
- Check that windows open and close properly and screens are not torn or missing
- Report loose shelving, and shelving units (48" or >) are to be secured to the wall
- Report stained ceiling tiles
- Power bars are to be used no extension cords for permanent wiring
- Wall maps and overhead screens are to be hung from L-brackets
- Door windows should not have anything covering them. The inside of your room must be visible from the hallway.
- Heating vents and air returns should be clear of all materials
- Fire-rated doors (door closers) should not be wedged open
- Cord/cable covers for traffic areas to prevent trips
- Sterisol in the Music room cannot be used in a spray bottle and the container with decanted Sterisol must have a WHMIS label (see caretaker)
- All items/hazards must be reported to the Principal and caretaking immediately throughout the year
